

# *Scott's chasing elusive medals*

TOP tradesman Scott Zeller, 21, of Normanhurst will be among 35 Australians jetting off to Taiwan this month to contest the International Youth Skill Olympics.

The young cabinetmaker will compete against the best from 38 nations when the Olympics start in July.

Australians will contest categories as diverse as cookery and carpentry, waiting and welding, industrial electronics and information technology.

International Skill Olympics are held every two years to promote international standards of vocational training and competence. Australia's best result in the 45-year history of the Olympics came in 1988 with a third place.

The four-day competition will conclude with a medal presentation and closing ceremony on Monday, August 2.
