Award-winning Sydney cabinetmaker Scott Zeller (pictured right) has given a ringing endorsement of the Fly collection by Milan furniture manufacturer Arte Brotto. "This collection of dining tables, chairs and wall cabinets has subtle and stylish curves, and traditional methods such as dovetail drawers and elaborate inlaid motifs that you never find in manufactured furniture," he says. The collection walks the line between contemporary and classic and is produced in a rich European cherrywood with tiny sleek smoked steel tongues for handles.
